2. Specific Conditions

2.1 Special Surfaces

Sealing surfaces, sealing edges, polished surfaces etc. have to be protected and packed, that any kind of damage will be avoided.

Holes must be sealed, especially flanges by using caps, which are protecting the sealing area as well.

Circular blanks must be protected and packed in an adequate way to prevent scratches, grooves and marks.

2.2 Elastomere

The delivery note has to contain your compound number and the manufacturing date of the semi-finished goods and the delivered sealing materials (such as plates, o-rings, etc.).
